All Colonial Heights residents 18 years and younger and those enrolled in CHPS programs are eligible to participate.

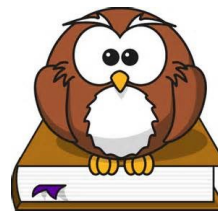
Parents may pickup w/out student present. Proof of a student in your home may be required.
